Applications to stand as a candidate city to host the 18<sup>th</sup> World Conference of Historical Cities from **Andong** (Republic of Korea), **Dujiangyan** (China), and **Odessa** (Ukraine) have been officially accepted. They will give presentations at the 17<sup>th</sup> World Conference and the host city will be selected by vote.

A call for candidacy for the host to the 19th World Conference will be issued in the second half of 2021.

The FY2020 Board of Directors' Meeting was held online on September 10, 2020. Normally, the meeting takes place in a host city every year, but the meeting for this fiscal year was held online for the first time ever due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
